TRAFFIC WARNING

- I-65 South is shut down for 5 miles in downtown Louisville (see map) below, including the interstate to the feis venue.
- Competitors should allow additional time for travel as the detour route may be longer than expected!
- Use a navigation app in case of traffic detours/delays.

Accessing Downtown Louisville Hospitals

- Jefferson Street from southbound I-65 remains open.
- Northbound I-65 detours drivers to westbound I-264 to eastbound I-64 to the Jefferson Street exit.

Accessing the Kentucky Exposition Center

- Northbound I-65 to westbound I-264 to Crittenden Drive for Gates 2/3/4
- Westbound I-264 to Exit 11 to Main Gate or Gates 2/3/4
- Eastbound I-264 to Exit 11 Crittenden Drive for Gates 2/3/4
- After July 1: Southbound I-65 to Crittenden Drive for Gates 2/3/4
- After July 1: Southbound I-65 Exit 131B to Fair/Expo Main Gates

Accessing Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport

- Northbound I-65, follow overhead detour signs to the Airport
- Eastbound I-264 to Exit 11 to the Airport
- Westbound I-264 Exit 11 to the Airport
- After July 1: Southbound I-65 to Exit 131B to the Airport

SCHEDULE

- 7:00am - Registration opens inside East Hall A/B.
- 7:50am - Opening ceremonies, national anthems, dancers report to stages.
- 8:00am - Competitions begin!
- 11:00am - all soda bread & art competition entries must be submitted at the ART competition table.
- Lunch breaks will be determined by each particular stage. Signs will be posted when stages are at a stopping point.

SPECIALS

- Treble reel will take place just prior to the lunch break on Stage 4.
- Gary Major Championship Cup comps will take place at the end of the day on Stage 4 starting with hard shoe.
- Future Champ comp will take place on Stage 1 after PC comps are finished.

PC/OC NOTES

- PC/OC comps will start in SOFT SHOE.
- Competitors will dance 2 at a time in the soft shoe round for all age groups.
- Competitors will dance 2 at a time in the hard shoe round for U16 & over, 3 at a time for U15 & under.
- PC & OC results will be announced at the PC/OC awards area.
- Please check the awards announcement schedule at the PC/OC awards area for exact times.

GRADE RESULTS

- Collect your awards on your way out of the feis.
- First feis-OPW awards will be ready 30 minutes after a dancer's last result has been posted on QuickFeis.
