Burke Connolly Feis and Feis Na Tara 2021 Covid-19 Guidelines

The information below contains major Covid-19 guidelines for the Burke Connolly Feis and Feis Na Tara events. Additional details will be out closer to the feis weekend.

Key Guidelines:

- Under Georgia law, O.C.G.A. § 51-16-3: "Any person entering the premises waives all
 civil liability against this premises owner and operator for any injuries caused by the
 inherent risk associated with contracting COVID-19 at public gatherings, except for gross
 negligence, willful and wanton misconduct, reckless infliction of harm, or intentional
 infliction of harm, by the individual or entity of the premises." By entering the feis venue,
 you will be subject to this law.
- Each dancer will be permitted ONE spectator in the ballroom.
- Colored wristbands for the dancer and spectator must be picked up at the registration table.
 Dancers and spectators may not enter competition rooms except during their registered competition.
- Temperatures will be taken upon entrance to the competition area. Any person with an above normal temperature will not be allowed in the competition space.
- Please plan to arrive no more than 30 minutes before your competition and depart after awards have been announced. Arrive warmed up and ready to dance.
- Face masks are required to be worn properly at all times, except when dancers are on stage. Dancers should bring a bag to put their face mask in side stage.
- Champ and grade stages will be split with one dancer at a time.
- Chairs in the ballroom will be placed in groups of 2 to observe social distancing requirements.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be located throughout the competition area.
- Dancers must bring their own water. Food can be brought in or purchased at the venue.
