How Does This Work?

- Register and pay online at <u>www.quickFeis.com</u> for the feis up to OCT 1
- As soon as you pay for your registration you will be given your dancer number on your QuickFeis account – PRINT IT!
- Practice and film your video
 - Use your smartphone for the video
 - Must wear your <u>dancer number</u>
 - o Must be in landscape more
 - Dancer must be <u>alone</u> in video
 - Music must be clear
 - o Create a separate video for each dance
 - No editing allowed
 - See additional guidelines below
- Starting OCT 3 go to VideoFeis and log in with your QuickFeis account you can start to upload all your videos
 - You may begin to upload your video no sooner than OCT 3
 - ALL videos must be uploaded by 8:00 pm OCT 4
- All videos will be securely viewed by adjudicator(s) who will score and give comments.
- QuickFeis will tabulate all scores
- All results will be posted on QuickFeis website – an email will be sent when results are ready – it will take a few days to adjudicate.

Entry Fees

- Full payment is due at time of registration. Your registration is not complete until your payment is received.
- All unpaid registrations will be dropped at the end of online registration period.
- US Funds ONLY will be accepted
 - Online registration will accept credit card payment only.
 - Sorry no checks or cash is accepted at any time
- Fees for non-champ are PER dancer and PER dance
- Championship fees are PER dancer only
- Full payment must be made at the time of registration
- Online registration will close on OCT 1
 Afterwards no additional registrations or changes will be accepted.
- Sorry NO REFUNDS!

Feis Rules

- The Feis Committee reserves the right to combine or split competitions.
- The Feis Committee reserves the right to close registration early or to not accept new registrations at the feis.
- Since this is a class feis your results don't count for moving up in regular competitions. But it does give you something to work towards and you will get professional outside feedback.

Costume Options

- Rohan Murphy Academy Feis or Team Costumes.
- White or black short sleeve t-shirt or leotard, black bottoms (shorts or short skirts).
- Poodle socks, or boys black socks / Girls white socks
- Solo costumes with black tights or poodle socks.
- Correct Soft and Hard Shoes Please.
- Natural hair or wig. As long as its off your face.
- Makeup optional for dancers age 11 and up.
- Please contact your dance teacher if you have any questions regarding what to wear

Numbering System

The following numbering system is used in this syllabus

1 st Digit	Level Category: FIRST FEIS Dances all begin with "1", BEGINNER with "2", ADVANCED BEGINNER "3", and so forth			
2 nd and 3 rd Digits	Age Group, Girls begin at 01 and Boys begin at 51. So "05" means girls under 5, while 61 means boys under 11.			
4 th and 5 th Digits (Letters)	Competition Type: RL = REEL LJ = LIGHT JIG SJ = SLIP JIG TJ = TREBLE JIG HP = HORNPIPE PD = ST PATRICK DAY TS = TRADITIONAL SET			

AGE GROUP: your age group is determined by the YEAR the competitor was born. This changes from year to year!

Video Rules

- Dancer will only be allowed to submit videos for competitions they entered and paid for.
 - o Grades will submit one video per dance competition
 - Prelim champs will submit two videos (one soft shoe + one hard shoe)
 - Open champ will submit three videos (soft shoe + hard shoe + set dance)
- All videos must be submitted within the noted timeline. No late entries will be accepted under any circumstances.
- Dancers are expected to create an original new video of their dance – a video that has been recorded AFTER they registered for the competition
- The dancer registered for a competition must be the dancer dancing on the video (no substitutions allowed)
- Background should be neutral and as light (white) as possible to create contrast with the dancer – this is a recommendation and NOT a requirement.
- ONLY THE DANCER IS ALLOWED IN THE VIDEO Teachers/parents/others may NOT be visible
- Video equipment should not be more sophisticated than a standard smart phone. The quality (resolution) and size of the video is limited to what is produced by a smartphone.
- Videography should be from a single static point (pretend you are the center judge sitting at a table)
 - Camera should be about 4 feet (125 cm) from the ground
 - o Camera should be in front center of the dance floor (avoid being on the side)
 - Videographer can pan side to side to keep the dancer full body within the video frame
- Video must be in LANDSCAPE mode (not portrait mode – see image below)

- Video for each dance must be one continuous front FULL BODY SHOT – head AND feet must be visible at all times throughout the video.
- The video must be cropped with dancing to start no later than 2 seconds after the beginning of the video, and no more than one second after dancing has ended.
- No editing of the dancing portion of the video is allowed
 - Any spliced videos will automatically be disqualified
 - Videos are not to include any embellishment or photoshop type of touch ups
 - Video is strictly of the dancer dancing to Irish music
- The feis nor anyone working with the feis will not be held responsible for any personal injury, or property damage in the making and/or submission of the video.
- The feis reserves the right to refuse any video for any technical or rules reason.

Dancing Rules

- Music and dance must match the competition registered for. (For example, a HORNPIPE competition must have HORNPIPE music and dance HORNPIPE steps)
- DANCER MUST WEAR THEIR DANCER NUMBER
- ONLY THE DANCER IS ALLOWED IN THE VIDEO Teachers/parents/others may NOT be visible
- Must dance the same number of bars as at a traditional feis.
- At the end of the dance, the dancer should simply bow and the video should end. Please refrain from walking before bowing.
- No coaching is allowed on the video
 - Any visible or audible coaching will disqualify the video
 - o The only exceptions will be for beginner dancers who may need to be counted in
 - Beginners are allowed to have 8 bars counted before the start of the dance
 - When the dancer starts their steps, no more counting is allowed.
 - Only counting is allowed no other form of coaching is allowed

Music / Sound

- Music cannot be dubbed over the video the music must be played out loud to the dancer and video must capture both the dancer and music at the same time.
- All music must be pre-recorded music
 - o Traditional instrumental music only
 - o No singing / no vocal music
- No live music allowed (no musicians playing)
- Music must be loud enough to hear on the video
- Music speed must be according to the official syllabus and standard feis speeds
 - o No speed variations is allowed
 - Music cannot speed up nor slow down during a dance
- No other sound except the music and dancer's shoes should be heard on the video
 - No talking
 - No singing along
 - No coaching

Dance Floor

- Encouraged to dance on a proper safe dance floor (not concrete or carpet)
- Dancers are encouraged to dance on an 8ft x 8ft (or 2.5 m x 2.5 m) minimum space.

Competitions

- With the feis organizer's input, VideoFeis will organize all the submitted videos into competitions.
- Just like a traditional feis, competitions may be split or combined
- After registration numbers are finalized, dancers/parents will be notified of the time limitation they will have to submit their videos.
- Dancers must submit their video within the timeframe listed on this syllabus:
 - o Upload starts on OCT 3
 - o Upload ends at 8:00 pm on OCT 4

Adjudication

- The feis organizers will hire the adjudicators it wishes
- Only accredited CLRG persons will be asked to Adjudicate the videos
- The feis organizer will decide how many Adjudicators will judge each competition.
- Adjudicators will be randomly selected to judge competitions
- Adjudicators whose dancers are entered in the feis will not be allowed to judge any competition with their own dancers
- All adjudicators will be encouraged to give copious comments along with their scores
- Judging will take place over several days, because adjudicators can only view one video at a time. Timing is dependent on the number of entries.
- Each adjudicator will be asked to judge all the dancers within a competition or a round, for those scores to be valid and tabulated for final results
- Adjudicators will be asked to monitor the tempo of the music – any tempo that is not appropriate will disqualify the video
- Adjudicators will be permitted to disqualify any video that they deem is "cheating" or is not following the video rules, or in the spirit of this competition
- In matters pertaining to judging, the decision of the adjudicators is final

Results

- VideoFeis will submit the comments and scores to QuickFeis for tabulation.
- QuickFeis will process and post all results on the QuickFeis website as they normally do for a traditional feis.
- School/Class feis results are limited to be viewed only by their school. Outsiders will not be able to view these results.
- Dancers will receive the same results they would at a normal feis – raw scores, rank, and comments
- Any awards will be at the discretion of the feis organizers

Permissions

Before uploading any videos on the VideoFeis site, participants will be requested to carefully read and grant the following permissions:

- <u>BASIC Permission</u> is REQUIRED before uploading any video.
 - This permission grants VideoFeis permission to show all videos to VideoFeis staff, feis organizers, dancer's dance school teacher(s) and feis adjudicators only.
 - Videos with only BASIC permission are considered PRIVATE and will be deleted directly after the completion of the feis.
 - By registering and agreeing to the basic permissions required, participants agree that their registration, competition information and data will be shared between QuickFeis and VideoFeis and the Feis organizer.
- <u>ADDITIONAL Permission</u> (optional) will be requested and may be denied for VideoFeis to use the videos for:
 - Winner's or showcase video compilation to be posted online
 - Testing for VideoFeis development and improvements
 - Videos with additional permission granted will be deleted within two months after the completion of the feis.

Privacy

- All submitted videos automatically become the property of VideoFeis
- All submitted videos are by default marked as PRIVATE unless additional permissions are given upon uploading
- All submitted videos can be watched by:
 - o Feis Adjudicator(s)
 - o Feis Organizer(s)
 - School dance teacher(s) (of that dancer)
 - VideoFeis staff
- QuickFeis and VideoFeis will share all data with each other and the feis organizer.
- QuickFeis and VideoFeis will not share nor sell any data or videos with any third/outside party.

Release of Liability

By registering and paying for this feis, parents and dancers agree to release the Rohan Murphy Academy of Irish Dance, Lauren Edberg, QuickFeis, and VideoFeis of any liability for any injury to complete any requirements for this competition.
